

Bible Character series of readings – week 30

22nd May – Elijah

Monday: 1 Kings 17:1-9. The prophet & the ravens: In this situation Elijah experiences God's provision and deepens his sense of dependency on Him. How confident are you that God can meet your need today no matter how big or small?

Tuesday: 1 Kings 17:10-24. The prophet & the widow: Sometimes, just like this widow, when we are down to nothing, God is up to something. What can we learn from the way she responds to Elijah's request?

Wednesday: 1 Kings 18:22-39. The prophet & Baal: For a number of years, Baal had captured the attention of God's people. Likewise, so many things can capture our attention pulling us away from God. Has God got your full attention and what can you learn from what Elijah did to rectify the problem (v30-32).

Thursday: 1 Kings 19:1-16. The prophet & his feelings: As fear gripped Elijah's life because of a message that Jezebel sent to him, he listened to the wrong voice, ran and hid. Today, find a quiet place and begin to listen to the voice of God instead and allow him to strengthen you in your journey.

Friday: 2 Kings 2:1-14. The prophet & his chariot: As Elijah and Elisha journeyed together, Elisha received what he had asked for because he kept his eyes constantly on his master. As we continue to walk with God each day through thick or thin, let us fix our eyes on Jesus, the author and perfecter of our faith.
