

Bible Character series of readings – week 39

24th July 16 – Isaiah

Monday: Isaiah 6:1-13. A definite call: As God calls, Isaiah responds. His task was not going to be easy. His message would fall on deaf ears and they would be blind to the truth. Whatever God is calling you to do, respond by saying, “Here am I. Send me!”

Tuesday: Isaiah 12:1-6. A praising heart: Here was a song that was later sung by those who had been exiled from Judah and were returning after long captivity. As you look back over your life’s journey, why not spend time thanking God for the things he has brought you through.

Wednesday: Isaiah 40:12-31. A great God: Rhetorical questions are used to persuade the people to trust in the Lord who is able to deliver, strengthen and restore. Whatever you are going through, trust in the Lord, focus on who God is and what he is able to do.

Thursday: Isaiah 53:1-12. A coming Messiah: Isaiah foresees the Messiah giving His life for mankind, His burial, His resurrection and his return to heaven. Give time to focus on what Christ has done for us upon the cross, the one perfect sacrifice that brought reconciliation between us and God.

Friday: Isaiah 55:1-13. A heart for the lost: Isaiah describes life apart from God in the first two verses which stirs him to express what life could be like for all who would come to know Christ. The great news is the gospel is for everyone. Who will you share the good news with today?
