

## Bible Character series of readings – week 42

14<sup>th</sup> August 16

**Monday: Daniel 1:3-20. Compromise spurned:** Daniel decided not to eat the royal food even though it could endanger his position and perhaps his life but instead lived to please God. How did God bless him and what does that teach us about compromising the things of God?

**Tuesday: Daniel 2:1-23. Wisdom displayed:** Not long into their court duties, Daniel and his friends faced a severe test. What did Daniel do to resolve Nebuchadnezzar's troubled mind? What is troubling you today? Why not thank and praise God the way they did in verses 19-23.

**Wednesday: Daniel 3:13-28. Confidence displayed:** As Daniel and his friends were thrown into the blazing furnace they were confident that God was able to rescue them and they put their trust in Him. No matter what you are faced with today, you can have confidence that God will stand with you.

**Thursday: Daniel 6:6-23. Faith demonstrated:** As Daniel is thrown into the lions' den his faith is tested. As morning approached no harm had come to him. Today, God is able to rescue you and bring you through your most difficult moments.

**Friday: Daniel 9:1-19. A prayer presented:** Daniel was, above all things, a man of prayer. His study of the scriptures and who God was drove him to pray this prayer. What aspects of God are found in these verses? Begin to use these to lift your voice in prayer.
