

## Bible Character series of readings – week 53

### 30<sup>th</sup> October 16 - Titus

**Monday: 2 Corinthians 7:5-13.** Titus was a comfort to Paul (v6) because he had been refreshed by the repentant attitude of the Corinthian Church (v13). How can you be a comfort or an encouragement to someone else today?

**Tuesday: 2 Corinthians 8:1-21.** Titus had a similar attitude to Paul regarding generous giving, and so he was trusted by the apostle to encourage the Corinthian Church to take up a special offering to support the famine stricken church in Jerusalem. What do you learn about Titus and about generosity that you can apply in your own life?

**Wednesday: Titus 1:1-16.** Titus was left on Crete to appoint leaders in the churches there and help them get established. What can you do or what role can you fill to help the Church become more effective in it's ministry?

**Thursday: Titus 2:15.** Are you included in any of the groups that Paul gives instructions to? If so, how should you respond? If not, which verse challenges or encourages you most? How will you respond?

**Friday: Titus 3:1-11.** In verses 1-8, Titus is encouraged to remind the people what God has done, so that they might "devote themselves to what is good." (v8) Why do you think divisive people who focus on things that are "unprofitable and useless" should be treated so firmly?
