NEW KID'S MINISTRY GROUPS

NATIONAL MONTH OF PRAYER FOR CHURCH TODDLER GROUPS

These sheep have all be taken to Parliament on 1st June to highlight the vital role of toddler groups for young children and parents and carers.



Our prayer points have been broken into the 4 weeks of June.

Prayer points for our church toddler group 'Little Steps' that meets on a Monday morning.

Week 1:

Pray for our children

- For the children to start to understand about Jesus the Good Shepherd and how He loves them.
- For their development in these early days - where every day counts to forming their brains, bodies and characters.
- For them to enjoy their time at Little Steps on a Monday morning & find it a place of fun and safety.
- For those going to school and nursery in September - that they will transition well and build healthy relationships quickly.
- For safeguarding for these children in their homes and places they visit.
- For early recognition of any development issues or special needs that will help the children meet their full potential.

Evangelism/Outreach:

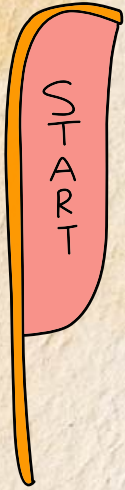
Pray that the Holy Spirit goes ahead preparing the ground, softening hearts, removing scales and giving opportunities for conversations and invites for the following:
